Safety measures are important when using a scaffold. Training in how to use scaffolding properly is essential for reducing the risks of serious injury or death to those working on, under, or near scaffold equipment.



This is a must for **ANYONE** who anticipates working on a scaffold. All employees that work on a scaffold must be trained.

1926.454(a) - The employer shall have each employee who performs work while on a scaffold trained by a person qualified in the subject matter to recognize the hazards associated with the type of scaffold being used and to understand the procedures to control or minimize those hazards. The training shall include:

- 1926.454(a)(1) - The nature of any electrical hazards, fall hazards and falling object hazards in the work area
- 1926.454(a)(2) - The correct procedures for dealing with electrical hazards and for erecting, maintaining, and disassembling the fall protection systems and falling objects protection systems being used
- 1926.454(a)(3) - The proper use of the scaffold, and the proper handling of materials on the scaffold
- 1926.454(a)(4) - The maximum intended load and the load-carrying capacities of the scaffold used
- 1926.454(a)(5) - Any other pertinent requirement of this subpart
